Tell someone 5 things that make you happy. How do you know they make you happy?

Grade 4 - Grade 9

Find time this week to do 5 things that make you happy. Record a video to make someone laugh.

PreK - Grade 3

Draw a picture of family include grandparents and the people closest to you. Count the number of people in your picture.

Grade 4 - Grade 9

Create a poster that shows your relationships to the people closest to you. List the strengths of each person.

How do I feel?



PreK - Grade 3

Explain to someone how you feel right now, take those feelings and paint or colour a picture using the colour that represents how you feel.

Grade 4 - Grade 9

Pick a colour and collect pictures that are only this colour. Create a collage with these images.

What can I do?

Spend time outside! Create a maze and have someone in your family go through it.

Help your parents or your neighbour while practicing social distancing to do spring cleaning, raking leaves, collect litter, or organize recycling, etc.
